ABSTRACT

This short article very briefly reviews some of the causes and results of American driven wars in Afghanistan, Iraq, Kashmir, Libya, Palestine, Somalia, Syria, Venezuela and Yemen, as well as the war the U.S. is about to start against Iran, as a prelude to suggesting what may be the only way to begin to stop American government driven aggression around the world. The influence of a “freer” media during the Vietnam war and its role in ending that war is cited as an example of how a new adult, uncensored news media internet site could help in ending some of America’s current wars and prevent future wars. Money for the military industrial complex comes from American taxpayers, and perhaps those tax payers need see and listen to the carnage – the incredibly vast human suffering and death their tax dollars are paying for in order to end the slaughter of innocents in Africa, Asia and Latin America. Other necessary support strategies to put an end to corporate dominance over American military political decisions are also suggested.

What are the problems? Industrial-scale murder, torture and theft of and from millions of innocent people around the world primarily committed in the “developing world” by the richest 1% in the world who live most comfortably in the USA and Europe, utterly free from any worry or concerns of exposure or criminal prosecution. No, the military industrial complex grows ever larger and the murder, torture and theft of natural resources in the developing world escalates at increasing rates. The United Nations has failed and continues to fail every day of every year totally and completely in its mission to prevent war.

Is it time to try something different?

Obviously yes.

I. The “Problems”

FACTS

- The United States Department of Defense, in conjunction with the CIA, and a vast labyrinth of organizations often collectively referred to as the “Invisible Government” (see list below) are the biggest killers and child abusers in world history (some specific examples and statistics cited below with references).
- As time moves forward, and mass killing using missiles and drones replaces “boots on the ground” (armed soldiers) larger and larger percentages of innocent men, women and children are being wounded and killed as the result of America’s hyper-aggressive foreign policies. This video is not ISIS propaganda. It's produced by the UN Human Rights Council.

Until now UN organizations including the UNICEF and UNHCR only has presented photos of happy smiling children, or at worst children that appear sad, as if they didn't get the birthday gifts they wanted, as compared to having survived, or not survived war and death.

UNICEF and UNHCR, as well as the full spectrum of human rights organizations have shrouded the ultimately brutal effects of the American military industrial profit-driven wars behind pastel photos of happy and mildly sad children, so-as to sooth westerner's anxieties about how their tax dollars are spent, e.g. on industrial-scale murder, torture and theft.

For a change recently, the first time to my knowledge, the United Nations Human Rights Council exposed the real brutality of the American endless wars on children in the above video. It's not "exploitation of victims" as the Neo-liberals would grandly proclaim to silence those who wish to expose the reality of war - it's a wake-up call. Is the UNHCR finally realizing how absolutely the U.N. is failing to live up to its mandate of preventing and ending wars?

While making the documentary Dirty Wars, Scahill met the survivors of secret US hit squads in Afghanistan, Pakistan, Yemen and Somalia – and promised to tell their stories.

In Afghanistan the American Department of Defense has realized its ultimate goal: endless war:

“In a rare and commendable effort to break through the corporate media silence and resulting public apathy, the BBC set out to track the violence of the war in Afghanistan in more detail for a single month...

“The BBC counted an average of 74 men, women and children killed each day, a total of 2,307 people killed in the month of August, with another 1,948 people wounded.

“The report broke down the numbers of people killed both by who they were and by how and where they were killed. The BBC classified the dead as 1,007 anti-occupation fighters (Taliban, Al Qaeda and IS), 675 government troops and police, 496 civilians and 3 U.S. troops...

“The BBC was able to broadly identify how 2,089 of them were killed: 844 in armed clashes; 515 in air strikes; 255 by snipers or targeted killings; 249 in explosions; 118 by shelling; and 108 in ambushes...

“The BBC counted only the lowest confirmed number of people killed in each incident, dropping conflicting reports of higher casualties, and, as the report said, “hundreds of reports were excluded and the true number of attacks and casualties could be much higher.”

“The number of combatants killed in Afghanistan is also largely unknown and ignored. The international media were surprised when President Ghani revealed in January 2019 that 45,000 Afghan troops and police had been killed since he took office in September 2014. If the BBC’s finding that government troops and police were about a third of the people killed in August 2019 was also true for the period Ghani referred to, total Afghan war deaths for those 52 months would have been about 130,000 to 140,000...

“But like the BBC’s August death count in Afghanistan, ACLED’s figures from Yemen are probably still only a fraction of the actual number of people killed. Passive reporting is still just passive reporting. ACLED cannot detect every Saudi air strike or every firefight in remote areas of Yemen any more than the BBC’s reporters could detect every air strike or night raid on remote villages in Taliban-held regions of Afghanistan...

“This has led me to conclude that the true death toll in America’s post-9/11 wars is not in the tens of thousands, nor even in the hundreds of thousands, but in the millions.”

According to Israeli human rights organization B’Tselem:

"You'll notice right away that the overwhelming majority of the deaths are Palestinian, and have been for the almost 14 years since B’Tselem began tracking. Overall, the group has recorded 8,166 conflict-related deaths, of which 7,065 are Palestinian and 1,101 Israeli. That means 87 percent of deaths have been Palestinian and only 13 percent Israeli. Put another way, for every 15 people killed in the conflict, 13 are Palestinian and two are Israeli. (Statistics for the past two months are from United Nations Office for the Coordinator of Humanitarian Affairs.)

"They recorded 8,166 conflict-related deaths, of which 7,065 are Palestinian and 1,101 Israeli. between the year 2000 and 2014.

"Since 2005, 23 out of every 24 conflict deaths have been Palestinian."

“Over the weekend, two senators introduced changes to the Israel Anti-Boycott Act, which would criminalize participation in certain political boycotts targeting Israel. The changes attempt to address the civil liberties concerns raised by the ACLU and other groups.

“Unfortunately, the revised bill still violates the First Amendment. It does so by unconstitutionally penalizing Americans who participate in political boycotts of companies doing business in Israel and its settlements in the occupied Palestinian territories, if those boycotts were called for by international governmental organizations like the United Nations.

“This is impermissible. Political boycotts are fully protected by the First Amendment. The Supreme Court made that clear when it recognized, in a landmark 1982 decision called NAACP v. Claiborne Hardware, that the Constitution protected a 1960s boycott of white-owned businesses in Mississippi.”

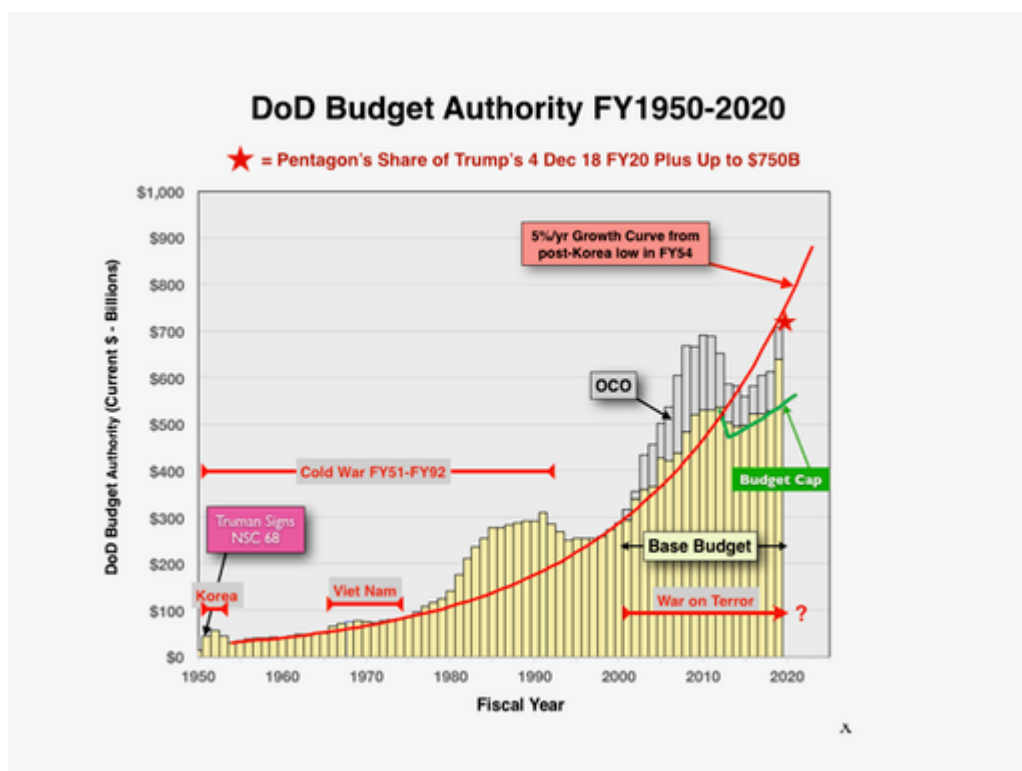

“Four recent national security studies by respected Washington think tanks and issue organizations address the current defense spending problem. They each cut DOD programs and change policies to save money. The 25 authors (some with decades of experience and for whom we have real appreciation) have written over 50 recommendations supported by considerable details. That the Democratic candidates have publicly ignored them all does not speak to the studies’ quality. Instead, it speaks to the candidates’ unwillingness to pick a fight with the horde of big spending advocates in both parties who will sling Pentagon- and corporation-written slick rebuttals, but certainly not campaign contributions, at any proposed reduction.

“Taken together, the four studies have three common themes:

- + The US wars in Afghanistan, Iraq, Yemen, Libya, Syria, Somalia and elsewhere—initiated or perpetuated by Presidents Bush, Obama and Trump—have “failed” and “have made the world more dangerous,” and something should be done. The ‘something’ varies from study to study.

- + The massive nuclear programs initiated by President Obama and expanded by President Trump should be partially reduced or eliminated—again, the recommendations vary.

- + A long list of conventional weapons, basing infrastructure and Pentagon military and civilian personnel programs should be cancelled or reduced...

“The four studies’ recommended cuts vary from \$1.25 trillion to \$3.5 trillion over ten years. Two of the studies state they want to spend the savings on domestic programs; the other two do not commit themselves.

“Each of the studies calls for “eliminating” the Pentagon’s special Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) account (“slush fund”), an account that was deliberately exempted from statutory budget caps on the basis that it was just to pay for the various wars. Not quite: for more than a decade the Pentagon and the Congress have been stuffing in extra and ever-growing non-war billions. Sadly, the studies have no advice on how to eliminate this slush fund... Effective action would be to simply repeal the provisions of the 1990 Budget Enforcement Act that permit money designated “emergency” by Congress and the President to be exempted from discretionary spending caps...

“There is no oversight of this broken system. For example, no one knows

The Absolute Need for Political Campaign Finance Reform in the United States

Appendix 1 – Proposed Request and Specifications for Photos, Videos and Personal Narratives from American Driven Conflicts Around the World

The Illumination Project: Blood of the Innocents is requesting that all survivors, and witnesses to American driven conflicts around the world send:

- authentic videos and/or photos of the realities of that violence and brutality, including torture and the deceased,
- detailed personal narratives of the realities of the brutality of these primarily American driven wars (preferably in English, however other language will be accepted – though lag time on translations will vary)

Respect for the Suffering of the Innocent and the Deceased

During the preparation phase of this project one team member asked: “Don’t you think it’s disrespectful of the suffering and deceased to post photos or videos on the Internet. My answer was and remains:

If I thought there was:

- some possibility of obtaining justice for the victim(s), and/or
- some possibility of preventing similar tragedies from happening to others,

I don’t believe it is disrespectful. I think allowing cruel abuses to continue unabated because of pride and/or honor is disrespectful to others who can so easily suffer similar cruel abuses in the future.

Specifications

- Time and date stamped photos are best, though not always possible. Thus,
- please attach a document with:
 - time of events recorded,
 - date of events recorded,
 - location of events recorded and
 - circumstances of the events recorded in photos/videos/personal narratives
- Please mention in that document if you want/need your name/identify kept confidential. All of this project’s records are stored on multiple external hard-drives, transitioned through smaller USBs for obvious security purposes. All USBs are re-formatted between uses to ensure there is no outward leak of information.
- Also please include a photo of your Identification if possible, and those of any other witnesses
- **If you send photos/videos or a personal narrative that might endanger you or others, please mark the potentially dangerous information as CONFIDENTIAL and it will be stored but not posted until such time as you notify the editors at The Illumination Project that it is now safe.**
- Please do not send fakes as they will be discovered and exposed as fakes sooner or later.
- Please do not send things you download from the Internet, unless you include the URL, download date and other background information requested above.
- **Please sign and date release form giving The Illumination Project: Blood of the Innocents permission to post the records you send on its Internet site.**

Once sufficient “critical mass” of documentary evidence (videos/photos/personal narratives) have been collected, The Illumination Project: Blood of the Innocents will go “live,” as at this point not enough original documentary evidence has been collected.
